Junior shooters, 12 to 17 years old, can join our Junior Development Program held on Saturday mornings from 10am to 12 noon at Australia's largest indoor shooting range –

The program will cater for juniors who are new to the sport or have had limited firearms experience. With a very strong safety focus it allows students to learn more about this fun Olympic sport. Our junior members shoot under the constant supervision and expert guidance of our Junior Development Range Officers.

This program runs for a 12-week period which excludes public holidays and school holidays. The course fee* is \$240 which equates to \$20 per week and is inclusive of all firearms, ammunition, targets, range time and tuition costs. A payment of \$60 is required to secure a booking with the balance of \$180 to be paid by the second week.

If a junior wishes to participate but does not possess a valid Minor's Permit (for category A & B) that is fine as the initial safety lecture, if completed successfully, will give them the ability to apply for one. Any junior without a permit must have a parent *or* legal guardian present to sign the required P650 declaration form on the day. The junior will then be allowed to participate whilst waiting on the issue of their permit. All participants are expected to apply for and receive their permit if they do not already hold one to continue in the course**

The cost of the firearms safe handling course (normally \$50) is also covered in the course fee. The Minor's permit is available through the NSW Police Firearms Registry and will cost \$75 and is payable to the Registry.

Next intake will be 8 September to 15 December 2018, this excludes school holidays, please see reverse for enrollment form. Bookings are essential.

Enclosed footwear must be worn to every attendance.

Stage One

Members may only shoot under the authority of a P650 declaration whilst awaiting the issue of their Minors Permit in the first weeks of Stage One. Stage One is only open to members 12 to 17 years of age.

Stage Two

This is restricted to Minors Permit or Firearms Licence holders only. Members over 18 years of age do not require parent/legal guardian signature. Stage Two is open to JDP members up to the age of 21 years. All new members (under 18) without a Minors Permit MUST complete Stage One and obtain a Minors Permit before being eligible for Stage 2. Continued participation in the JDP is conditional upon the member holding a valid NSW Minors Permit for the appropriate category of firearms to be used. Program members 18 years and older require a valid NSW adult firearms licence.

Code of Conduct:

- Listen to and obey all directives given by the Range Officer.
- Follow and abide by all appropriate firearms safe handling procedures.
- Participate in strict accordance with all appropriate SSAA NSW Branch and SSAA JDP rules & procedures.
- Be fair, considerate and honest with members, staff and visitors.
- Refrain from any form of harassment towards members, staff and visitors.
- Refrain from any form of personal abuse, whether verbal or physical, towards members, staff and visitors.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every human being.
- Actively promote the Association and the sport of shooting by positive action.
- Maintain a current NSW Firearm's Minors Permit covering both categories 'A' and 'B'.
- Maintain current financial membership of the SSAA.

Dress Code:

- Enclosed footwear must be worn at all times on the range.
- Sensible clothing - dress for the day's weather/temperature conditions.
- No clothing or images that are deemed to be offensive or inappropriate by the management is allowed.

Cameras, mobile phones, electronic games and music devices: The use of these items is forbidden on the range firing line and training areas. Photos may only be taken on the firing line with permission from the JDP Coordinator.

I have read and understand the Code of Conduct, Dress Code and information on cameras, mobile phone, electronic games and music devices and agree to abide by these. I also understand that serious or repeated breaches of the above may result in expulsion from the Program and the loss of any fees paid.
